

How to Search for Childhood Immunisation Records

For a record of all childhood immunisations given after 1996 and up until the child is of age 7, contact the Australia Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR) by visiting - www1.medicareaustralia.gov.au/ssl/acircirgcert or by calling 1800 653 809.

Alternatively:

- Contact the Council that administered the vaccinations to your child;
- Contact the clinic/doctors surgery that administered the vaccinations to your child; or
- Contact the Department of Health and Human Services (Immunisations) as they retain some old records of immunisation administered at child health clinics phone: 1300 135 513

How to Search for School Immunisation Records

School based immunisation records are held by each Council. Contact the local Council in the area which the school(s) your child attends or attended resides within to find out how to request a copy of the records held by the Council.

The City of Hobart has an online request system to request records of immunisation. The information from these online requests allows Council staff to generate and forward a copy of any immunisation records that the Council holds to you within 3-5 working days.
