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## **CITY OF HOBART – LIGHT UP THE TREE**

**Friday 29 November, 6–8.45 pm**

Location: Mawson Place 6–8.45 pm. Santa will be arriving at approx. 6.30 pm and we light the tree up at approx. 8.30 pm

The Light up the Tree event is an annual event hosted by the City of Hobart to celebrate and bring the community together for the lighting of the City of Hobart Christmas Tree.

This year's event will showcase various community groups performing on stage, face painting, roving performers and a meet and greet with Santa inside Waterside Pavilion. The Lord Mayor will officially light the tree at approx. 8.30 pm. This will be an  Auslan interpreted event.

## MYER HOBART CHRISTMAS PAGEANT

Saturday 16 November commencing 10.30 am

Widely recognised as Tasmania's biggest street parade, the Pageant marks the start of the Christmas season and brings the community together for a fun day in the heart of the city.

The 2019 Myer Hobart Christmas Pageant will be another fabulous event celebrating our diverse community.

Spectators should find a viewing spot by 10 am to make sure they catch the great variety of entertainment which will take place around the pageant route.

- An accessible viewing area is located opposite the pageant stage at the Liverpool Street end of Elizabeth Mall.
- In addition to the regular parking provisions in the City's on street and off street car parks, members of the public who are holders of a 'Transport Access Scheme Parking Permit' and require parking closer to the pageant route can access dedicated parking available in Bathurst Street (between Elizabeth and Argyle streets – approximately four spaces) and Collins Street (between Harrington and Barrack streets - approximately five spaces) – please refer to the map on the City of Hobart website a week prior for exact locations. - Small groups with mini buses are welcome to contact the City of Hobart on: 03 6238 2472 closer to the time of the pageant as an area may be available to park mini buses allowing passengers to view the pageant from the vehicle.
- Trained assistance animals (such as guide dogs) are welcome.
- Public toilets are located throughout the city, for locations download the 'The Toilet Map' App.

- For a large, informal family event with space for picnics and children's activities there is the New Town Community Christmas Carols hosted at Ogilvie High School and the Carols at John Turnbull Park in Lenah Valley – you can bring your dog along to these events.
- Smaller, more localised family events will be held at the Mount Stuart Hall, Mathers House and West Hobart Recreation Ground.
- A traditional carol event with choir and other musical items will be held at the oval of Guilford Young College in Patrick Street. The Korean Full Gospel Church in the city will be presenting a Korean choral group with a backup band and a supper in the church grounds.
- All events are free of charge for entry. Donations are welcome.
- While the event is free, Carols on the Hill will require reserving of tickets through [www.eventbrite.com.au](http://www.eventbrite.com.au)
- AUSLAN interpreters will be signing at two events, Carols on the Hill and the Carols at John Turnbull Park.
- Trained assistance animals (such as guide dogs) are welcome.

## THE TASTE OF TASMANIA

Saturday 28 December 2019 – Friday 3 January 2020

The Taste of Tasmania is Australia's biggest and longest running food and wine Festival. With stunning waterfront views, awe-inspiring performances, live music and local gourmet offerings The Taste is summer's not-to-be-missed community celebration.

Open daily from 11 am – 11 pm, except on New Year's Eve when the site will close at 3 pm to reopen at 6 pm for the ticketed New Year's Eve event.

- Carers are welcome free of charge to all Taste of Tasmania ticketed activities, including New Year's Eve celebrations. Please register the carer tickets at the time of purchase.
- In addition to pre-existing accessible parking locations within Sullivan's Cove, extra accessible parking will be provided close to the event site in the Murray Street car park. Please check the Taste website for directions.
- Accessible parking spaces in the Murray Street car park are managed by a security guard from 11 am to 10 pm daily. A five hour limit applies, please ensure relevant permits are displayed.
- A city mobility map can be found here for the best car parks in the area [hobartcity.com.au/mobilitymap](http://hobartcity.com.au/mobilitymap)
- A drop-off and pick-up area will be available alongside the event site at both the Morrison Street entrance Sunday to Friday and the Silo end of Castray Esplanade every day.
- Trained assistance animals (such as guide dogs) are welcome on both the buses and throughout the event site.
- There will be specific tables and chairs available throughout site to assist patrons with limited mobility and wheelchairs, tables will be noted on site maps and clearly signed.

- A wheelchair is available for hire on site from the Info Booth.
- For information while at the event please see the Info Booth located in the PW1 forecourt
- In the event of a medical emergency during the event call 000. For minor medical attention first aid providers are located in the Forecourt of PW1.

## CITY OF HOBART FLORAL SHOWS

The City of Hobart Floral Shows are a series of Spring and Autumn shows presented by local horticultural societies in conjunction with the City at the Town Hall, 50 Macquarie Street, Hobart.

The 2019–20 program includes the Dahlia and Gladiolus, Daffodil and Camellia, Orchid, and the Rose and Iris shows. The Rotary Club of Salamanca offers Devonshire teas and sandwiches for purchase at each event.

All floral shows are free entry and are held in the main hall at Town Hall.

- Lifts from the parking deck on Elizabeth Street and ground level on Macquarie Street are available for use to the first floor where the event is held.

- Drop-off and pick-ups are best done on the Town Hall parking deck accessed via Elizabeth Street, where there is ample room and less traffic movement.

## SALAMANCA MARKET

Enjoy the sights, sounds, flavours, action and colour of Australia's best outdoor market - proudly operated by the City of Hobart in Salamanca Place on the waterfront between Davey and Runnymede streets every Saturday from 8.30 am to 3 pm

- A park and ride service using a fully accessible bus is available every Saturday from the market to Council run car parks between 9 am – 2 pm, every 15 mins. Find more information here [hobartcity.com.au/salamancashuttlemap](http://hobartcity.com.au/salamancashuttlemap)
- A city mobility map can be found here for the best car parks in the area [hobartcity.com.au/mobilitymap](http://hobartcity.com.au/mobilitymap)
- Drop-off and pick-ups are best done along Castray Esplanade (except during The Taste of Tasmania event due to road closures).
- In addition to pre-existing accessible parking locations within Sullivan's Cove, extra accessible parking is provided in the car park between the two lawns on Castray Esplanade, this parking is managed by a City of Hobart staff member while the market is on (except during The Taste of Tasmania event due to road closures).
- Trained assistance animals (such as guide dogs) are welcome.
- For information while at the event please see the staff at the information booth located on the corner of Morrison Street and Salamanca Place.
- Free wheelchair hire is available from the information booth from 8.30 am - 3 pm every market day.
- An MLAK key, to unlock the Salamanca Place accessible toilets, is available from the information booth.
- In the event of a medical emergency during the event call 000. For minor medical attention please see the medical providers on Gladstone Street (between Parliament House Gardens and the Tasman Memorial).
