Title: Parking – Voluntary Organisations

Category: Parking Control

Date Last Adopted: 7 March 2016

1. Objectives

To define the authority of the Group Manager Parking Operations in considering parking concessions to Voluntary Organisations and the appeals mechanism available to an applicant.

2. Background

Voluntary organisations rely on donations and public support. Free parking is provided to assist in transporting frail patients and/or collecting donations.

3. Policy

That:

- 1. Applications for parking meter or off-street parking concessions, other than those covered by the policy, Elizabeth Mall Commercial Events Featuring Advertising, from Voluntary Organisations be considered by the Group Manager Parking Operations and that the employee be granted the authority to approve such applications where they are of the opinion that special circumstances exist.
- 2. Any request for a review by the applicant of the decision of the Group Manager Parking Operations be referred to the Finance Committee for individual consideration.
