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Introduction

The City of Hobart owns infrastructure and runs programs that can help increase public awareness of your event, day of cultural significance, festival or awareness campaign.

Our assets are available for hire and need to be booked ahead of time.

Each program has its own guidelines and terms and conditions and we are happy to help if anything is unclear. Contact details for the right person to connect with are included with each program.

The City has the following promotional options available:

- Civic Banner Program
- Festive Lighting Program
- Gateway signage
- Advertising screens Elizabeth Mall Information Hub.

The City of Hobart also offers grant funding to help with the costs of organising your activity:

- In-Kind Venue and Event Resource Quick Response Grant
- Community Quick Response Grant.

If you are planning an event or festival, you can talk to us about events equipment that we own and that you can hire.

This document provides overview information on each of these options.



Civic Banner Program

The City of Hobart has banner poles in locations across the city that can be hired, they add vibrancy to Hobart's streets and provide a fantastic opportunity to promote a message to a wide audience.

A typical three-week program can reach more than one million vehicles. Banners are located on poles in the city centre, along the main arterial roads and in the main shopping precinct areas of North Hobart and Sandy Bay.

To be eligible to book this program, events and activities must be sporting, cultural, recreational, community or tourism related. Events and activities that achieve one or more of the following objectives will be considered:

- held within Hobart municipal area
- increase visitation to Hobart
- provide direct economic benefits to the City
- national or international event of significant civic value.

Banner bookings for events and activities that promote a business will not be considered.

Festive Lighting Program

The City of Hobart has a range of lighting infrastructure that can be colour coordinated to raise public awareness for events and campaigns.

Locations include:

- Cardinal Lights (Mawson Place)
- Doone Kennedy Hobart Aquatic Centre (DKHAC)
- Elizabeth Mall
- Franklin Square fountain
- Kennedy Lane
- Rose Garden Bridge.

The Festive Lighting Program Guidelines provide further information and need to be read and agreed to before a booking application is submitted. Bookings must start and finish on a working day, and are for a minimum period of three days and a maximum period of one week.

Gateway Signage

The City of Hobart has gateway signage boards on the Tasman Highway (just below the Cenotaph) and the Brooker Highway (near Rugby Park). Special events and community messages can be advertised for up to four weeks.

Advertising Screens at Elizabeth Mall Information Hub

The Elizabeth Mall Information Hub is equipped with two large, retail-quality screens that provide 30-second advertising spots (no audio) on a permanent cycle, targeted at local pedestrian traffic through one of Hobart's largest pedestrian zones - Elizabeth Mall.

Videos (no audio) are to be supplied in highdefinition resolution in mp4 format. A selection of rotating slides (up to 5 per 30 seconds) is also possible.

Advertising rates:

- \$1000 per half year
- \$400 per month
- \$200 per week (ideal for short-term promotions, such as festivals and events).

The In-kind Venue and Event Resource Quick Response Grant provides funding of up to \$1000, and assists by waiving fees and charges for some City of Hobart-owned event equipment, venues, banners, signage or lighting.

COMMUNITY QUICK RESPONSE GRANT

The Community Quick Response Grant provides funding of up to \$1000 for activities that enhance community identity, encourage accessibility, celebrate the cultural life of Hobart and create opportunities that facilitate and encourage participation within the city.
