

RECYCLING – YELLOW BIN



With your help The City of Hobart is working towards zero waste to landfill by 2030.

12% of what is in a general waste bin can be recycled through your yellow lidded bin.

What goes in?

- ✓ Plastic bottles
- ✓ Paper and cardboard
- ✓ Glass jars
- ✓ Steel and aluminium cans
- ✓ Milk and juice containers

What doesn't go in?

- ✗ Plastic bags and bin liners - put items in the bin loose
- ✗ Polystyrene and foam trays, cups or packaging
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Clothing or fabric
- ✗ General rubbish
- ✗ Garden Waste
- ✗ Long life milk and juice containers - tetrapak

There are many other items that can be recycled through council facilities including: paint, batteries, E waste, mobile phones, scrap metal & CFL light globes.

Re-usable items that are too good to be thrown away including furniture, doors, windows, clothing, timber, metals & tools of all kinds can be dropped off or even picked up by the Resource Collective for re-sale or recycling.
