

CHICKENS

Chickens will help process bulk greenwaste and some food scraps through eating, scratching and pooing. Only feed your chooks as much food scraps as they can eat in one day, otherwise you'll attract rodents. Spread straw or woodchips through the chook's run as needed to maintain a thick, spongy "deep litter" where earthworms and soil biology will thrive.
