Use this form if you would like the footpath in front of or alongside your property excluded from the City's Urban Weed Control Program.

All requests are current for 24 months from 30 June the year of application, after this time your request will expire. If you would like to remain on the register you will need to renew your request using this form (selecting the renewal option).

Your request will be assessed and a confirmation letter will be sent to you at the end of the application period.

Applications are open for 2 months from 1 June until 1 August.

- By being on the no spray register it is the applicant's responsibility to control the weeds in the address listed on this request to at least the same standard that can be achieved by the City's herbicide control method and the area shall be maintained at regular intervals.
- Should the City deem that the control is not to a satisfactory standard as determined by it, under Section 2 (26) Code of Practice for Spraying in Public Places, the City may resume responsibility for the maintenance of the land, using herbicide products if deemed necessary.
- The City will undertake regular inspections of the property.
- Requests to be on the register are valid for 24 months from 30 June the year of application, after which time the request will expire. At this time it is the applicant's responsibility to renew their registration if they would like to remain on the no spray register.
- An orange delineator marker will be placed on the property boundaries on the nature strip or footpath to assist with identifying properties. Should the property be removed from the register the delineator will be removed.

Declaration
