
A guide to access facilities and mobility route planning for people with disability

## Free wheelchair service

A free wheelchair for use in the CBD is also available from the Argyle Street Car Park. Call 62 38 2796.

# Master Locksmiths Access Key (MLAK)

A MLAK can be provided to Hobart residents for free. Visitors to the city can loan a key.

You can obtain your own MLAK key from the Hobart Council Centre located at 16 Elizabeth Street, Hobart.

Visitors can borrow a key from the information desk at the Argyle Street Car Park, 38 Argyle Street.
