1. Greater investment on kunanyi / Mount Wellington

I fully support state government funding to sustainably maintain and develop kunanyi, in line with community consultation, including consultation with and consent from the Aboriginal community. Kunanyi is the most visited tourist site in the state, but receives little to no funding to even maintain its current (and increasingly unfit for purpose) infrastructure. The current model is unsustainable, and is becoming unsafe for locals and tourists.

2. Improved Public and Active Transport Infrastructure and a commitment to deliver the Hobart Transit Centre

I absolutely support and commit to advocating and voting for far greater state-level investment in public and active transport infrastructure. This is in the interests of providing greater mobility to people who have to work in and around the city, but have been priced out of living close to their jobs and the services (health, education etc.) they need to access, improving congestion, reducing wear and tear on public infrastructure, and will help us toward a more sustainable future.

3. Redevelopment of Doone Kennedy Hobart Aquatic Centre (DKHAC)

DKHAC is such an important piece of public infrastructure, and it's a shame that because of the politics of the day it cannot be maintained or upgraded to meet the needs of the community-- and I find it particularly revolting that it has not been able to receive funding to get it to standard for people with disabilities. I commit to advocating and voting for sufficient funding for DKHAC so that it is appropriate and accessible for the health and enjoyment of the whole community.
