Thank you for writing to me to outline the City of Hobart's 2021 Tasmanian State Election priorities, and for providing me with the opportunity to respond on behalf of the Tasmanian Labor Party. I apologise for my delay in response.

Labor recognises the significance of kunanyi / Mt Wellington as an icon of natural beauty to Hobart locals and visitors alike.

A Labor Government will commit to engaging with the joint managers of kunanyi / Mt Wellington, immediately post-election to explore opportunities for bringing your initiatives to fruition.

We would approach the redevelopment of the Doone Kennedy Hobart Aquatic Centre in the same spirit.

In respect of public transport infrastructure, I can advise that a Labor Government is committed to delivering all infrastructure projects within the budget, including the Hobart Transit Centre.

Further, Labor will establish a Cycling Infrastructure Fund and invest \$15 million over two years on cycling infrastructure projects around Tasmania.

Finally, I understand that Rebecca White MP, Tasmanian Labor Leader, will be writing to the Mayors of Greater Hobart regarding the priorities of the Greater Hobart Strategic Partnership.
